DESCRIPTION

This workshop will help the participants understand the history of sandtray play therapy work and the materials needed to put it into practice. Participants will learn the play therapy skills needed to process sandtray with their clients. Case studies, experiential learning, and play therapy videos will aid in this process. The role of the play therapist in sandtray will be examined as well as specific populations this modality works well with. Specific play therapy theories, techniques, rationale, and history specific to sandtray play therapy will be discussed. This workshop will also focus on personal growth through opportunities to create your own sandtrays.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. Describe the history and use of sand tray play therapy.
- 2. Demonstrate how to lead a client through a sandtray play therapy session, including describing the reason for sand tray therapy
- 3. Explain the process of a sandtray play therapy session and ending a sand tray session.
- 4. Apply the use of being present throughout a sand tray play therapy session.
- 5. Utilize ways to explore and assess client's narrative/private logic.
- 6. Prepare the client gain insight and make changes to their thoughts, feelings, and behaviors through the use of sand tray play therapy.
- 7. Develop and practice sand tray play therapy directive trays.
- 8. Demonstrate ways to apply directive sand trays with clients in play therapy.
- 9. Verbalize an Understanding of the link between how a child uses the sand and the activation in their nervous system
- 10. Demonstrate various ways to bring regulation into the sand tray to help deepen the child's experience
- 11. Describe the role of the therapist in sandtray play therapy sessions.
- 12. Identify materials used in sandtray play therapy
